Riding School: Horse Shows

There are limited spaces for the horse shows and they will fill up fast. There are only four to five ponies and four to five horses available for each class. Whoever signs up for a show first will have first pick of pony and class with trainer approval.

Horse Show Costs

Meadowville Fees are due two weeks in advance. Horse show fees can be paid on the day of the show. If a show is rained out, the cost of the show will be refunded or it can be used as credit towards another show.
